I, _____, a Ten Time Powder Pass Holder at Alyeska Resort, understand and agree to the following:

1. My Ten X Powder Pass must be worn at all times when I ski at Alyeska Resort. **This pass is non-refundable and non-transferable.** Pass sharing will result in immediate revocation of the pass without refund and will result in fines and revocation of skiing privileges for one full year for both me and the person caught using my Ten X Powder Pass.
2. **Rollover Unused Days:** Take any unused days on your Ten X Powder Pass or Ten X Midweek Powder Pass and apply the remaining credit towards the purchase of a 2012-13 Powder Pass. For Example: You have three (3) unused days on your 2011-12 Powder Pass. This means you will receive \$150 (3 x \$50 per day) of credit to be applied towards the purchase of a 2012-2013 Powder Pass. (Please Note: Midweek Powder Pass credit is based on a value of \$40 per day). **To take advantage of the rollover, you will need to purchase your 2012-13 Ten X Powder Pass by the October 31, 2012 deadline.** Credit will only be issued with the purchase of a new Ten X Powder Pass.
3. **If my Ten X Powder Pass is lost,** stolen, damaged, defaced or otherwise unusable, a replacement pass will be issued for a fee of \$10. I understand that **I must pay \$10 for all replacement passes.** If the Ten X Powder pass is lost or stolen I agree to immediately inform Alyeska Resort Ticket Office so my pass can be deactivated and a new pass issued. If and when I request a replacement for a damaged pass, I will bring any remnants of the pass to the ticket office. I understand that my replaced pass will be deactivated and will not work at the gates.
4. **If I forget to bring my pass,** Alyeska Resort will issue a replacement season pass for a fee of \$10. I understand that my old Ten X Powder Pass will be deactivated and will not work at the gates. I understand that **I must pay \$10 for all replacement passes.** I agree that the next time I visit Alyeska Resort; I will turn in my deactivated Ten X Powder Pass to an Alyeska Resort Ticket Office.
5. **The Ten X Powder Pass remains the property of Alyeska Resort.** The Resort retains the right to revoke the pass and refuse to sell me future passes if I disregard ski area policies (including those on the back of this agreement) or if I disregard directions given to me by authorized Resort personnel or if I disregard posted signage. A list of conduct violations and disciplinary actions is available for review at Alyeska Resort Ticket Offices or the Ski Patrol Building.
6. **With respect to Avalanche / Terrain & Trail Closures,** I agree to obey all terrain closures and posted signage. If I am caught out of bounds, I will lose my Ten X Powder Pass and skiing privileges for 14 days from the date of the infraction. A 2nd offense will result in loss of my Ten X Powder Pass and skiing privileges for 365 days from the date of the infraction. In both instances, I will be required to take the Mountain Education Test and will be required to pay fines and be subject to prosecution to the fullest extent of the law. If I am injured while skiing on closed terrain and am rescued, I agree to pay for all costs of my rescue, including, time, materials and any injuries sustained by any rescuer.
7. The duration of the skiing season, the skiing conditions and the amount of ski hill open for the public are subject to natural forces beyond the control of Alyeska Resort. Alyeska Resort makes **no guarantee** as to the quality of the skiing conditions, the number of days and/or nights which the ski resort, or portions of the ski resort, will be open or which portions of the ski resort will be closed for skiing.
8. The Ten X Powder Pass is valid for any ten days of skiing during the season and will expire on the last day of May skiing operations which is Memorial Day, Monday, May 28, 2012. May skiing operations are tentative and dependent on snow and weather conditions.
9. The Midweek Ten X Powder Pass is valid for any ten midweek days of the season (Monday through Friday, including midweek holiday night skiing, Thursday and Friday night skiing). The Midweek Ten X Powder Pass will not be valid on any weekend dates including May weekend skiing operations. The midweek Ten X Powder Pass will expire on the last day of May skiing operations which is Monday, May 28, 2012. May skiing operations are tentative and dependent on snow and weather conditions.
10. **I understand that under Alaska law, THE RISK OF AN INJURY TO PERSON OR PROPERTY RESULTING FROM ANY OF THE INHERENT DANGERS AND RISKS OF SKIING RESTS WITH THE SKIER. INHERENT DANGERS AND RISKS OF SKIING INCLUDE CHANGING WEATHER CONDITIONS; EXISTING AND CHANGING SNOW CONDITIONS; BARE SPOTS; ROCKS, STUMPS AND TREES; COLLISIONS WITH NATURAL OBJECTS, MAN-MADE OBJECTS, OR OTHER SKIERS, VARIATIONS IN TERRAIN; AND THE FAILURE OF SKIERS TO SKI WITHIN THEIR OWN ABILITIES. In addition, I understand that AVALANCHES AND SNOW SLIDES MAY OCCUR AT SKI AREAS, BOTH INSIDE AND OUTSIDE OF THE POSTED BOUNDARIES AND THAT AVALANCHES ARE AN INHERENT RISK OF SKIING DUE TO THE NATURE OF SNOW AND ITS APPLICATIONS ON MOUNTAINOUS TERRAIN.**

11. Much of Alyeska Resort lies within State of Alaska Department of Natural Resources permitted property. State regulations authorize Alyeska Resort to close areas due to avalanche or terrain hazards, or for the protection of public health and safety. Violations of these closures may be punished by a fine and / or revocation of skiing privileges.

Alyeska's schedule of operations is as follows, subject to item #7 above: Please read carefully.

- November 23, 2011 -- Tentative opening day.
 - Saturday December 17, 2011 -- Night skiing begins.
 - Holiday night skiing operations are 12/17/11 – 12/30/11 no night skiing on 12/24 & 12/31.
 - March 24, 2012 -- Last night of Night skiing operations.
 - Beginning April 1 through April 24, lift hours will change to 11am to 6pm daily.
 - April 29, 2012 -- Last day of 7 day a week winter operations.
 - May 4 – 30, 2012 -- May Weekend Skiing & Riding Operations (Fridays, Saturdays & Sundays & Memorial Day only) -- Tentative Chair 6 open for May skiing. Upload the Tram only. This is weather and snow conditions dependent. 2011-12 passes will be valid for May weekend skiing operations. Midweek Passes are not valid for May skiing except for Fridays and Memorial Day which is a Monday.
 - Memorial Day, May 28 -- Last day that 2011/2012 season passes are valid.
 - May 1, 2012 -- 2011/2012 Passes go on sale ~ visit www.alyeskaresort.com
 - **Oct. 31, 2012 – last day to roll over credit for unused days towards a 2012-13 Ten X Powder Pass.**

- Day skiing hours are 10:30am to 5:30pm.
 - Night skiing hours are Chair 1: 4pm - 8:30pm, Aerial Tram: 4pm - 8:40pm, and The Bear Cub Quad: 4pm - 9pm.
 - April Skiing Hours are 11am to 6pm beginning April 1st. There is no night skiing in April.
 - May Skiing Hours are 11am to 5pm. Upload/download the Tram and ski on Chair 6 only.

Select Ski Area Policies:

- A. Reckless or unsafe skiing will not be tolerated at Alyeska Resort. The guidelines used to define reckless skiing will be the "Your Responsibility Code", which is the standard used by the National Ski Areas Association.
- B. Skiers / Riders will be expected to ski slowly in areas marked "Slow". Going with the flow, with average skier / rider traffic speed, will be considered a reasonable rate for these marked areas. Skiing / Riding fast in slow zones will result in loss of pass privileges. **Violators will lose their pass privileges for a minimum of 7 days.**
- C. Jumping is a part of skiing, which many skiers / riders enjoy. Inverted jumping is considered dangerous. Inverted Aerials are allowed at Alyeska Resort' Terrain Parks and Super Pipe, Inverted Aerials are NOT allowed outside the Terrain Parks or Super Pipe. It is the responsibility of the jumper to ensure a clear run out / landing which is away from other skiers and all main runs.
- D. Skiers / Riders shall not ski / ride while under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- E. Skiers / Riders shall not build or enhance jumps anywhere on the slopes of Alyeska Resort.
- F. Skiing or riding Out of Bounds or in Closed Areas will result in loss of pass privileges and may incur additional fines
- G. Skiers / Riders are responsible to avoid other skiers / riders on the mountain. The skier / rider below you has the right of way.
- H. **If you are involved in a collision with another skier / rider, you agree to stay on the scene of the accident and wait for Ski Patrol to arrive. You agree to cooperate fully with Ski Patrol. Leaving the scene will result in loss of pass privileges, skiing/riding privileges and will result in prosecution.**
- H. Skiers / Riders must look up hill when merging.
- I. I understand that I must sign, initial and date the Ten X Powder Pass Agreement before my Ten X Powder Pass will be activated. I will deliver my signed 2011 / 2012 Ten X Powder Pass to the Tram ticket office or fax to 907-754-2576.

A SKIER IN VIOLATION OF THE ABOVE POLICIES OR OTHER ESTABLISHED ALYESKA RESORT POLICIES WILL BE SUBJECT TO FINES AND/OR REVOCATION OF SKIING PRIVILEGES. If I am a parent or guardian of children with an Alyeska Resort Ten X Powder Pass, I accept responsibility for informing my children of Alyeska Resort policies governing the use of a Ten X Powder Pass as well as all general policies and rules that govern skiing at Alyeska Resort. I accept full responsibility for my child's actions while he or she is at Alyeska Resort.
