YOUR SCHEDULE

7:15 - 8:15am PICK UP TIMES: You will be picked up at your pre-arranged bus stop at these approximate times: Eagle River 7:15am or Anchorage 7:45am - 8:15am (all times 30 minutes later in April due to changing mountain operations hours)

8:45 - 9:00am ARRIVAL AT ALYESKA RESORT: Your group will have a color assigned to them. You will locate your group's sitting area in the Daylodge by the color you have been assigned. Chaperones will organize your backpacks in the Daylodge. You will receive your lift tickets from your team leader. Groups will be called in order of arrival to the Rental shop, so you can receive your gear: boots, skis, snowboard, etc. When you are ready, your Team leader and chaperone will escort you to the lesson meeting area. You will be grouped according to your ability for your lesson.

10:30am - 12:30pm LESSON TIME: Your instructor will dismiss your class in front of the Daylodge. Please check in with your team leader or chaperone in the Daylodge after your lesson.

12:15pm - 1:30pm LUNCH TIME

1:30pm - 3:30pm UNSUPERVISED FREE TIME: Ski school suggests that you use the buddy system while skiing or snowboarding. Rental equipment should be turned in between 3:00pm and 3:30pm, so you are ready to get on the bus by 4:00pm.

5:00pm - 5:30pm DROP OFF TIMES: You will be dropped off at your pre-arranged bus stop at approximately these times; Anchorage - 5:00pm, Eagle River - 5:30pm.

HOW TO REGISTER

Visit our website: www.alyeskaresort.com. The website will walk you through the registration and payment process. You can pay online with a credit card. There will be a release form to print, sign and turn into your team leader. **Your child's registration is not complete until Alyeska Resort receives payment.**

TRANSPORTATION

Each ski/snowboard day, your child will be picked up at the time and location specified by your Team Leader/Chaperone. (Anticipate buses will depart approximately 7:30-8:00am and return by 5:30pm, depending on your location. Check with your Team Leader for your specific times and location. **Always check the conditions before departing for the bus by calling the Snow Hotline 754-7669. This is very important as weather closures do occur.**

WHAT TO WEAR & BRING

We recommend a warm waterproof jacket with hood, ski pants or snow bibs, sweater, turtleneck, long underwear, hat and neck gaiter, gloves, wool socks (not too thick), goggles, sunglasses, boots. Shirt and pants should be wool or polar fleece. Do not wear blue jeans under snow pants or as snow pants. Bringing cameras and other personal equipment is at your own risk. Please mark your child's belongings appropriately. Meals are not included in this program. Participants are responsible for bringing their own lunch/ snacks or money to purchase food from the Daylodge cafeteria. There are combo meals for \$10.00 – \$15.00 offered at the Daylodge. Your child will work up a good appetite, so plan accordingly.

REFUNDS & MAKE UPS

Please check schedules carefully for conflicts before registering your child for this program. There are **NO REFUNDS** issued once the student has been officially registered, except for the following circumstances: injury or moving out of the area. In the case of injury, a pro-rated refund will be issued based on the number of weeks missed. Make-up vouchers **WILL NOT** be issued for missed weeks. If you provide your own transportation and your child is late for a lesson, they may be unable to join the group. If Alyeska cancels a session for any reason, there will be one make-up day for all participants in the block. If the participant cancels, there will be no make-up. If your child is registered for **Level One of the Discover Program** and misses the first day, a refund will be issued, since the child will not be able to catch up to the rest of the group.
